



Castle Hill School Parents' Evening June 2021





For the first time, parents and carers were invited to complete an online questionnaire following Parents' Evening. They were also offered a paper copy if they wished.


Results of Questionnaire following Parents' Evening (22 Respondents):






*From the graphs above, it can be seen that there are two instances where families disagreed with statements. These were followed up with conversations between the parents concerned and members of the Senior Leadership Team to find the cause of the issues. In one case the issue was already resolved. The other issue was resolved through the follow-on conversation.

Parents were invited to suggest ideas for Parents' and Carers' Information sessions to be held next year. One parent asked for advice regarding adaptations and the Disabled Facilities Grant (DFG), and how best to advertise for Personal Assistants. Some parents asked for face-to-face Information sessions, while others indicated that they would be interested in accessing sessions through Microsoft Teams or similar.
