Miss out some of the key words 'hat' 'sun', 'hooray'. Can you sign, make a sound or an action in the gaps? Can you make a big sound, stretch your arms for 'hip hooray'?

Things to do and make:

Draw a big circle for a sun.

Colour it in or use some yellow materials to make a collage.

What else can you find that is 'yellow' or a 'circle'?

Explore yellow materials and use them to make circles e.g. bend a pipe cleaner, draw in custard, thread pasta, make shapes with cooked spaghetti.

Try on lots of different hats. What is your favourite?

Make a sun catcher (there are lots of ideas on the internet using tissue paper, food colouring even beads).

Make a collection of things beginning with 's'.

Make a collection of 'summer' things and choose items to pack in a 'summer' bag for a day out. Don't forget your sun cream!

Write or sequence the letters for some of the words in the song 'sun', 'hat', 'got', 'on'. How many new words can you make by changing just one letter?
